A fruity nose with hints of peach, then fresh and well-balanced on the palate with a round texture lifted by notes of citrus fruit. Organic agriculture provides a very clean and fresh feel throughout the whole palate.

From a father and son with an absolute passion for their vines, this is a vibrant, mineral, thoroughbred classic from Central Loire.

Pouilly-Fuissé Pascal Clément, Mâcon, 2015 52

Coming from the most prestigious and famous vineyard of Mâcon; hazelnut and grilled almonds on the nose and a creamy peach fruit on the palate, an elegant wine drinking beautifully now.

Italy

Pinot Grigio, Torre Dei Vescovi, 2018 4.7 / 6.6 / 9.5 / 27.5

Golden yellow in colour, it is delicate and complex with floral notes. Presenting a velvety smooth, pleasantly fresh dry finish.

Gavi di Gavi, Villa Doria, Alessandria, 2018 36

Straw yellow in colour, with mild greenish highlights. Its nose is packed with hawthorn floral and fruit aromas, especially green and golden delicious apples. It is pleasantly crisp in the mouth thanks to a balanced acidity and good structure. Its mineral finish is characteristic of its terroir.

New Zealand

Sauvignon Blanc, Mt Holdsworth, Wairarapa, 2019 6.4 / 9 / 12.9 / 36

This North Island Sauvignon marries the variety's typical zesty, grassy aroma to real texture and succulence. Green apple and passion fruit flavours turn crisp and mineral on the finish.

Pinot Gris, Outnumbered, Matahiwi Estate, 2018 31

Fresh aromas of elderflower and yellow roses. The palate has a luscious mouthfeel, with warm fruit flavours of lychee, citrus zest and nashi pears balancing the vibrant finish. A good match for pork and apple sauce, and an excellent match for spicy food.

Well rounded and harmonious, with notes of tinned peaches and fresh herbs, a fresh juicy palate and a long, mouth watering finish.

Good punchy Shiraz aromas of mulberry and plum, supported by hints of vanilla and coffee oak. The palate is juicy, spicy and satisfying, with a rounded finish.

A complex nose with soft mocha, plum and blackberry flavours. Rich and soft on the palate with ripe tannins. Medium to full bodied with a good length.

Côtes du Rhône, Samorëns, Ferraton père et Fils, France, 2017 35

Medium to full-bodied, the bright, fresh cherry and berry fruit is followed by a savoury earthy note. The tannins are silky and well-rounded and the finish is fresh. Top quality winemaker pushing boundaries of modern wine making.

Fleurie, Domaine de la Bouronière, 2017 38

Grown on pure granite soil, it has a bright red colour with violet glints and a bouquet of iris, rose and raspberry, the palate is fresh & supple. Marc's favourite!



Beaujolais-Villages, Château Des Vierres, Duboeuf, 2016 35

Attractive cherry coloured wine with a bouquet of strawberry and blackcurrant. Smooth and well balanced.

Crozes Hermitage, Maison Les Alexandrins, Drôme, 2017 46

Two great families of the Rhone; Nicholas Jaboulet & the Perrin Family of Château de Beaucastel collaborated to produce top quality Northern Rhone Wines. This superb example of Shiraz has fragrant aromas and flavors of soft black cherry, blackberries with a hint of smokiness. Intense well-integrated tannins make this a fruity delicious wine.

St. Emilion Grand Cru, Château de Saint-Pey, 2015 52

This beautiful family owned 16th century Chateau lies in 17 Hectares of South facing vineyard. Mainly Merlot its elegant red fruit aromas and berry flavours makes for a silky smooth and aromatic finish, a truly elegant wine.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine de Nalys, Rhone, 2015 55

Shows dark fruit flavours, such as black cherry and blackcurrant, spiced with liquorice and aromatic herbs; the palate is full-bodied with fine-grained tannins which gives it a smooth finish.

Margaux, La Reserve d'Angludet, 2016 62

A classic dazzling Bordeaux blend from this respected family property in Margaux. Deep purple in colour, delicious blackberry jammy fruit and hints of vanilla, a well-regarded vintage, elegant and charming.

Chassagne – Montrachet, Vincent Morey, Bourgogne, 2017 70

Great Bourgogne. A deep and well balanced wine with notes of peaches and lots of flowery tones. Complex and good tannins with flavours of oak and black currants coming through.

Soft and easy-drinking red from the 'heel' of Italy. Packed full of black fruit flavours, with a dash of savoury tannins and appetising acidity.

Organic Montepulciano, Montipagano, Umani Ronchi, Abruzzo, 2017 34



We have here the best company making wine in the Abruzzo region. Plentiful fresh red berries lead onto pleasing herbal flavours and subtle notes of spice from the oak. The palate is medium-bodied, with elegant, well-rounded tannins and a long, fresh finish. Blockbuster and proof of high quality in the region.

Fontodi Chianti Classico 'Panzano', 2015 55

On the hills of Panzano just north of Siena this family property makes some of the best Tuscan wines. 100% Sangiovese, handpicked it has aromas of red berries and ripe summer cherries. In the mouth blackberries and plums, soft silky tannins and as Jancis Robinson said, very good.

New Zealand

Pinot Noir, Featherdrop, Hawkes Bay, 2017 36

This charming wine offers aromas of blackberry, raspberry, smoky oak and floral notes. Sweet ripe cherry and raspberry flavours complement the fine structure and subtle spicy oak. Wonderful as an aperitif or paired with one of our many lighter meat dishes.

Portugal

Tinto, Prunus, Dão, 2016 5.9 / 8.25 / 11.8 / 30



Lightly oaked and perfectly balanced, with a silky texture and crisp edge. The nose is cram packed with mulberries, blackberries and anise. On the palate black cherry and raspberry fruit tones with creamy and chocolatey oak flavours. Harry's favourite!

Pudding Wine & Port

France

Sauternes, La Fleur d'Or, Bordeaux, France, 2015 **100ml / Bottle**
7.5 / 30 (37.5cl)
An immediately inviting nose, combining apricot fruit, creamy patisserie notes and a certain citrus brightness, leads to a sweet yet beautifully balanced palate. Luscious but never cloying.

Hungary

Royal Tokaji 'Late Harvest', 2016 **7.5 / 30 (50cl)**
Aromas of apricot and a hint of orange peel later turning to honey, this classic pudding wine is rich yet delicate and lingers forever.

Portugal

Tawny Port, Ferreira, Douro, Portugal, NV **5.75 / 29**
A fresh, delicate aroma, reminiscent of spices and dried fruit, reflecting the oak ageing. In the mouth this is an elegant wine that shows a fine balance between structure and sweetness, providing it with an attractive long finish. Lighter in body but still big powerful flavours.

Port Reserva, Ramos Pinto, N.V. **5.5 / 28**
The perfect end...from one of the few remaining family-owned Port lodges.

Taylor's Late Bottled Vintage Port, 2011 **6 / 30**
Classic Late Bottled Vintage Port wine, from top quality producer.
